



Norfolk Scouts County Shooting Competition
Saturday 7th October 2017 – 10.00 am to 4.30 pm
1st Taverham Scout HQ, Sandy Lane, Taverham, Norwich, NR8 6JR

Rules

Each District may enter 2 teams with each team consisting of 4 scouts.
All participants must be over 10 years and under 14½ years of age on the date of the competition.

County air rifles and pistols will be used to ensure a fair competition.

Completed Permission to Shoot and One Day Activity forms together with the entry fee of £20 per team to be sent to Steve Reynolds, 25 Priors Drive, Old Catton, Norwich, NR6 7LJ, **to arrive no later than Saturday 23rd September 2017**. Cheques should be made payable to Norfolk Scouts County Shooting ASU.

Each District taking part should provide one supervising adult.

Format

Event will consist of air rifle and pistol competitions using .177 rifles and pistols with the team total scores being added together to identify the overall winning team.

There will be four disciplines and teams will rotate during the day to complete each.
Trophies will also be awarded to the winning team members and the individual Scout with the highest total combined score.

Air Rifle Competition

- Standing with rifle at 10 metres – 5 practise shots followed by 3 scoring targets of 5 pellets each
- Kneeling with rifle at 10 metres – 5 practise shots followed by 3 scoring targets of 5 pellets each. Target height = 1 metre
- Prone (laying) with rifle at 10 metres – 5 practise shots followed by 3 scoring targets with 5 pellets in each. Target height = 25cm

Pistol Competition

- Pistols at 6 metres – 5 practise shots followed by 3 scoring targets with 5 pellets in each

Pistol will be loaded by Instructors and only fired by Scouts.
Scout may shoot holding the pistol in either one or both hands.

Other Information

All members should arrive and depart in uniform. Neckerchief to be worn throughout the competition, but competitors may change into comfortable clothes for shooting activities.

Parking will be available at Taverham Village Hall (opposite the Scout HQ) for leader parking and for parents when dropping off and collecting scouts.

Competitors should bring a packed lunch, all snacks for the day and a non-breakable mug. Drinks only will be supplied.
