Welcome to Norfolk Scouts Airlines Flight 2020 which will be taking off on Monday 27th July and travelling to various locations around the world with Captain Louis.

What is it?

Each week Captain Louis will be on Radio Norfolk around 9.10am announcing his destination where you can travel with him and undertake some exciting activities when you get there.

Where will I find it?

The challenges can be found on the Scouts in the Sky tab on www.norfolkscouts.org.uk with a new pack uploaded each week. There are 5 weeks of destinations for you to join us on.

Each week there will be an activity sheet posted with a wide variety of things for you to do, using things you will find at home, or at minimal cost. You can take part it all of it or some of it for each destination as you wish.

Do I need a passport?

On the next page is your Scouts in the Sky Passport – you can complete it and take a selfie of yourself or draw a picture of yourself on it.

There are also 6 rectangular boxes – for you to research the flags of the destinations and colour these in the correct colours – note on one week there will be a stop off - hence 2 destinations.

Is this for Scouts only?

This is open to anyone, any age that wishes to join in – and if you are in Scouting or Guiding please keep the evidence and pictures of everything you have done to share with your leaders in September - this can count towards badge work.

Is there a social media page?

Yes - there is the Scout in the Sky Facebook page where the weekly destinations and challenges will be posted You are more than welcome to share any pictures of what you have been up to onto there if you wish. To follow the page all you need to do is to 'like' it.

Is there a badge?

If you like our Scouts in the Sky Badge (as below) – these can be ordered if you want them (they are pin badges but can be made into keyrings, or medals as well) – please order direct or groups can order in bulk – Gemma just needs you to confirm it is the Scouts in the Sky logo to use when ordering. 
