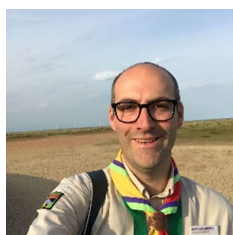
We've got some exciting times ahead at Norfolk Scouts as we aim to grow, become more youth shaped, inclusive and integrated into our communities.
