

The Four Missions

As part of the Young Leaders Scheme there are four missions to complete

The Missions are designed to allow the Young Leaders to put the learnt throughout the modules into practice.

It is important that section leaders are aware of any upcoming missions, what they entail and the ways in which they can support the YL working with them to complete their mission.

Mission One - Games

Plan and run a minimum of three games.

The games should be varied incorporating:

- At least one games should take place indoors and one take place outdoors
- At least two different types of leadership styles i.e. Directive (YL runs it) or Team-based (working with another YL / leader to take equal responsibility) (Module B and Module C)
- Three different types of games i.e. Elimination or Energetic or Observational or Skill-based or Teambuilding (Module E)

This could be a game that ties into an activity badge or a game played just for fun.



Mission Two - Activity

Plan and run an activity (not a game).

The activity must include:

- Planning and organisation
- Preparing any resources
- Delivery

This activity could be running a base as part of a badge/award, leading an activity during a camping experience or providing an activity relating to a personal hobby/interest.

Mission Three – Programme Planning

Plan a Youth Forum and relay feedback to the other leaders at a programme planning meeting.

This mission must ensure:

- Young people's views are captured and incorporated into their programme

When completing this mission, it is an opportunity to use the Association's resources for youth led Scouting.

Mission Four – Programme Delivery

Take responsibility for organising and running part of the sections programme.

This mission must include:

- Planning and organising a selection of activities relating to a theme
- Delivery of the planned activities
- Review of the activities delivered

This could be planning and running a meeting night, activity badge or challenge award. Alternatively it is an opportunity to run a camp or event.
