#### TASK 1 : Make your own didgeridoo

##### EQUIPMENT:

Paper tube (like from the inside of wrapping paper, paper towels or multiple toilet rolls)

White paper

Crayons or pens

Tape



## INSTRUCTIONS:

- If you are using smaller tubes tape them together to form one long tube (how long you make it is your decision)
- Find as much white paper as you will need to cover the tube and cut to size
- Make your own 'aboriginal art' design on the white paper
- Cover your tube with the design and tape it in place (If you don't have white paper or want to draw directly on the tubes that works also)

- Felt tips

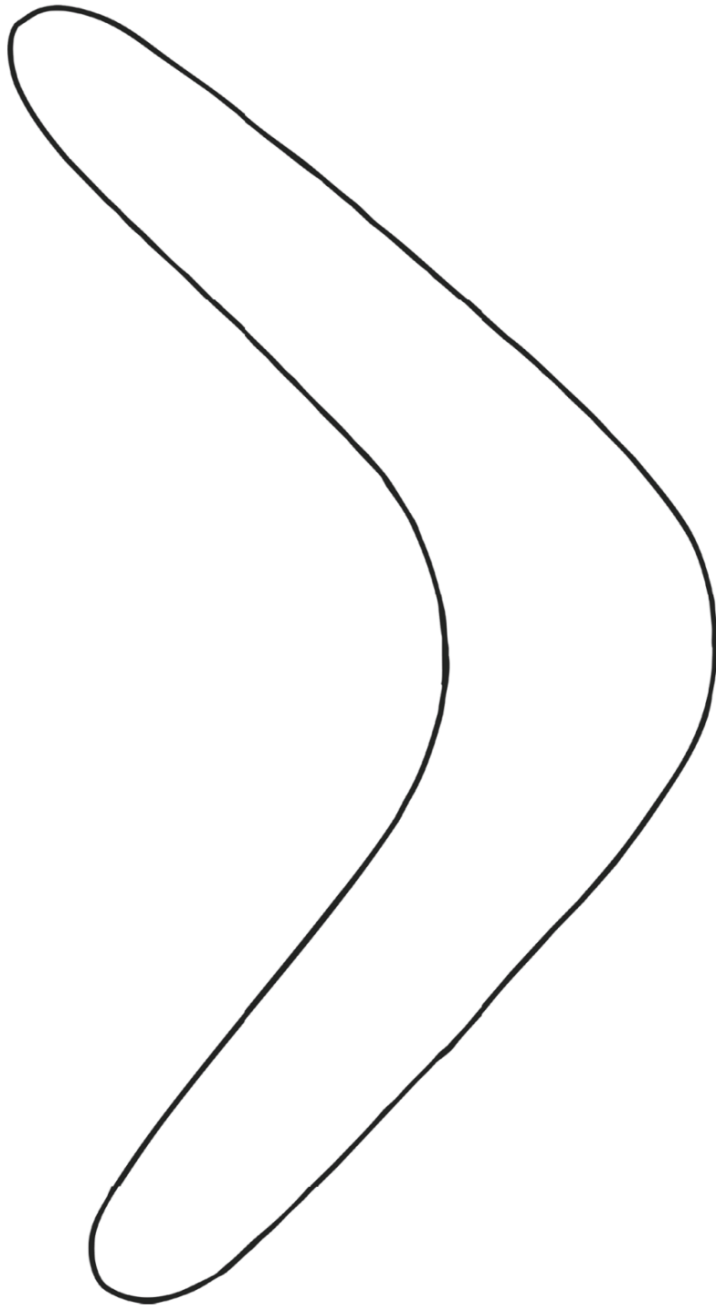
**INSTRUCTIONS:**
